Subject: Park Ranger's Monthly Narrative Report, July, 1950

Maintenance

The fences of the various ruins groups of Hovenweep National Monument were checked during July. Wires were found cut in a number of places, probably to allow entry of sheep during the previous winter's herding season. Repairs are being made.

Weather Conditions

The weather during July has been generally cloudy or rainy. In spite of inclement weather, roads leading to the Monument were in fair condition.

Visitors

The travel for July was down somewhat from previous years. There was a total of 44 visitors from seven states.
