Proclamation No. 2998 of November 20, 1952, has reminded us of the need for clarification or an agreement regarding the official acreage to be used for Hovermoop National Monument.

Our NFS-L-1 sheet, deed No. 1, shows the acreage to be 299. % acres. Proclamation No. 29% dated April 26, 1951, is shown on NPS-L-1 sheet as 124.52 sores and designated as deed No. 2.

The proclamation of November 20, 1952, added 31.02 acres making the outbined total for Hovenmon 501.88.

On March 11, 1952, a dopy of Superintendent Rose's memorandum of March 6 was transmitted to your office calling attention to the printed figure of 410.32 acres as shown in the June 30, 1951, published "Areas Administered by the National Park Service." Mr. Rose pointed out that the resurvey of Sections 2 and 3, 7. 36 N., R. 20 W., completed June 3, 1942, by the Comeral Land Office increased the original acreage from 205.00 to 299.34. The latter figure with the prodlemation of April 26, 1951, brings the total acreage to 123.06 rather than the published figure of 1,10.32 acres.

Mr. Richay in his memorandum of March 18, 1952, a reply to Mr. McColm's manorendum of March 11, 1952, suggests that we use the published figure of 120.32 acros. It is this figure that seems to us to be in error and the one which we feel should be corrected so that the present total acreage for Hovermoop National Monament can be shown as 50h.88 acres.
