Subject: Cancellation of Withdrawal Adjacent to Goodman Point

Ruins, Hovenweep National Monument

By Secretarial Order (no number) of September 16, 1889, Section 4, T. 36 N., R. 17 W., N.M.P.M., was withdrawn for the proposed Goodman Point Ruins National Monument.

As you know, by two Presidential Proclamations, Lots 2 and 3, $SW_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}NE_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}$; $SE_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}NW_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}$ and $E_{\underline{2}}^{\underline{1}}SW_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}NW_{\underline{u}}^{\underline{1}}$ have been added to Hovenweep National Monument. By Secretarial Order the $S_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ has been cancelled from the withdrawal. Still included in the withdrawal, but not included in the Monument, are Lots 1 and 4, SELNEL and Was William.

We shall appreciate it if you will advise us if you concur in our belief that the latter described lands can now be recommended for cancellation from the withdrawal.
