MEMORANDUM for the Director,
Bureau of Land Management.

Lowry Ruin, located in Lots 5, 6, and 7, Sec. 2, T. 38 N., R. 19 W., New Mexico Principal Meridian, Montezuma County, Colorado, covering 128.01 acres, was withdrawn by Executive Order No. 5201 dated October 3, 1929, pending determination as to the advisability of addition to Hovenweep National Monument.

It has been determined that this ruin falls in the category of an exhibition for interpretation only, and, comparing it with other excavated sites, especially those already under the supervision of the National Park Service, it is felt that it is not of sufficient value to add to the monument.

It is recommended, therefore, that Executive Order No. 5201 be revoked.
