Subject: Proclamation No. 2924 of April 26, 1951 Enlarging Hovenweep National Monument; Order Partially Revoking Secretary's Order of September 16, 1889, Colorado

Attached is a copy of the above Proclamation as published in the Federal Register dated May 1, 1951, page 3667, adding certain public lands to the Hovenweep National Monument.

There is also attached a copy of an order signed today revoking in part the order of the Secretary of the Interior dated September 16, 1889, which withdrew certain lands in Colorado pending examination with a view to ascertaining their condition and historical value. The revocation order will soon be published in the Federal Register.

Please acknowledge the receipt of this memorandum immediately and make the appropriate notations on your records of the order of revocation.

The Acting Manager's memorandum of May 7, 1951, reported that the withdrawal made by the Proclamation had been placed on your records and that part of the land is embraced in oil and gas lease Puehlo 060281 issued September 1, 1948. It is assumed that the procedure outlined in Part 57.130 (b) of the BM Manual providing for notice to oil and gas leases on reserved lands, has been followed.
