Subject: Proposed Goodman Point (Aztec Ruin) National Monument, Colorado

Further reference is made to your memorandum of March 28, 1951, concerning the Secretary's order of September 16, 1889, in connection with the above project.

The order has been revoked by my order of this date as to the $S_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ sec. 4, T. 36 N., R. 17 W., NMFM, Colorado. The revocation order will soon appear in the Federal Register.

Lot 2 and $SW_1^1NE_2^1$ sec. 4, containing the Goodman Point Ruin were added to the Hovenweep National Monument by Proclamation No. 2924 of April 26, 1951 (16 P.R. 3687). The National Park Service on May 9, 1951 reported that additional ruins have very recently been found on the remaining portions of the N_2^1 , and stated that its recommendations as to retaining or releasing these remaining lands will be furnished hs after further investigations.
