Dear Dr. Quortrup:

It is my understanding that a herd of buffaloes is maintained at the Colorado National Monument, and that it is the intention of the Park Service to have these animals rounded up some time this winter. The local park officials at that station have no knowledge of tests having been made on these animals for the presence of Brucellosis. They are interested in having blood samples examined and after the young stock is rounded up on that occasion, it would be advisable to vaccinate as many as are available.

You will receive further information on this matter from the Park Service.
