MEMORANDUM for the Regional Director, Region Three.

Reference is made to my memorandum for the Director of this date, copy of which is being furnished you, on the matter of disposal of surplus bison at Colorado National Monument.

These operations will require heavy pole corrals that may have to handle up to twenty-nine bison. I have in mind two corrals connected by a gate that can be opened from the outside. The trapping corral should have a substantial entrance gate rigged up with a trigger that can be operated from some distance by wire or rope.

X ( Probably Region Two Headquarters will be able to furnish some standard plans, as similar facilities are in use at Yellowstone and at Wind Cave.

Project Construction Program form, Colo-M-10, Buffalo Corrals, is being prepared and will be in your office shortly.
