Memorandum for Superintendent Miller,
Southwestern National Monuments

Reference is made to Memorandum W-13-12 concerning the Federal
Park Use Study.

The Washington Office has requested that this Office make in-
quiry as to the non-receipt of Forms FPU-1 in the Washington Office
for the following national monuments under your jurisdiction:

- Gila Cliff Dwellings National Monument
- Howenacke National Monument
- Natural Bridges National Monument
- Rainbow Bridge National Monument
- Yucca House National Monument

Undoubtedly the reason for the non-receipt of the requested
forms is due to the fact that there is no custodian in the area.

For your information the following excerpt is taken from Mr.
Herbert Evison's memorandum of May 18 which may be of assistance
in interpreting instructions outlined in Memorandum W-13-12:

"Most of the reports which we have received have been properly
filled out; however, there still seems to be some confusion regarding
the transfer of the 'total guest days' at 'campgrounds' from Block II
to Block I. Frequently the 'guest days' opposite 'campgrounds' in
Block II, is listed opposite 'Total camper days' in Block I. This
item should be included in the 'total guest days' and should be re-
corded with the total of other items in Block II opposite 'Total
guest days (accommodations)'. Only the total of 'camper days' as
entered in Block III should appear opposite 'total camper days' in
Block I. It has been possible for us to make the adjustments on
the reports so far submitted but, of course, this extra work could
be eliminated if the forms were filled in properly on the areas.
In some cases also the reports are not signed and it is desired that
every report bear the signature of an official on the area. A
regular monthly report on Form FPU-1 is desired even if there be no
information to report for any particular month.
