Dear Sir:

Receipt of your card of June 4, addressed to the Custodian, Hovenweep National Monument, Route 2 - Box 544, Tucson, Arizona, is acknowledged.

I am afraid that in some manner you have gained information which must be inaccurate. There is no resident Custodian at the Hovenweep National Monument, which is located some distance south-east of Blanding, Utah, along the Utah-Solo state line.

Since I have never been to Hovenweep myself, I cannot supply you with any first hand information concerning the area. It is my impression that the roads are quite poor in that section, and that travel is possible only in the summer months. Mr. Dale King, c/o The Regional Director, Region Three, Box 1728, Santa Fe, New Mexico, would be able to answer any questions you might have concerning the monument.

No published informational literature on Hovenweep exists, so far as I am able to determine. I am enclosing two folders which contain location maps, and one of which briefly describes the features of the monument.
