the word "rights" at the end of the fourth line, and inserting the words "and the provisions of existing withdrawals."

The departmental order of September 16, 1889, withdrawing the lands for possible inclusion in a national monument, will be revoked after the proclamation is signed, as suggested in Assistant Director Wirth's memorandum of December 28, 1949 (L32 REG 3). The order establishing Colorado Grazing District No. 4 will also be revoked at that time so far as it affects the lands to be added to the monument. This will leave only the public water reserve, which would be protected by the suggested wording in the proclamation.
