



- -Learn of existing and new connections between the OER and DEI initiatives on our campus

- -Contextualizing OER





Operationalizing Equity and Open Education

Develop comm strategies that connect OER and equity: make the work visible

Offer professional development aligned with OER and DEI

Articulate the impact of OER and DEI implementation

Embed DEI into OER course redesign or development grant programs

Connect equity and OER into institutional mission statements, strategic plans, and a list of recommended steps for the successful implementation of the strategy



Some lessons I learned from the rubric

Play the long game, acknowledge other perspectives
It legitimizes what you are saying / name recognition
Cast a wide net for unlikely partners and fellow advocates







More lessons

Meet very regularly to get the deliverables completed.

Bounce your work off your campus AOER committee (or others from the open community if you don't have a committee)

Have a back up plan in case there is turnover on your team.

Make a plan to share your work widely and incorporate it into formal university plans.





More lessons learned

Messaging from a variety of voices is important: cost savings and beyond

Listen to students and share what they say

Stick to your plan and make adjustments

Do what works at your institution
